CSL seniors drop-in centre expected to open in late August

Côte St. Luc council last week officially approved a partnership agreement with the Cummings Centre for the planned seniors drop-in centre at the Aquatic and Community Centre, replacing the one that was based at the CLSC René-Cassin.

The centre has been providing a respite for caregivers of people with Alzheimer's and other conditions requiring constant care. This past April, Mount Royal MP

Anthony Housefather announced that the federal government would be providing \$390,913 over three years for the centre through its New Horizons for Seniors Program.

Housefather took on the issue as Côte St. Luc mayor and MP when the existing program underwent changes last year, as did current Mayor Mitchell Brownstein.

Councillor Dida Berku told last week's council meeting that the new centre will include a designated room and wash-room.

"The room at the ACC has been completely renovated, we've invested quite a bit in a new kitchen," she added. "The room is absolutely spotless and well equipped. The bathrooms are equipped for those who are handicapped, and we're looking forward, at the end of August — date to be announced — to have the inaugural session, the first time the seniors are going to come to the ACC. It's going to be quite exciting." ■
