# Dorval Airport has never looked so good

I remember the days when I would take connecting flights, getting off in airports in places like New York City, Atlanta and Philadelphia. Layovers were fun, given the wide array of restaurants and virtual shopping malls on site.

Over the years, Pierre Elliot Trudeau International Airport (I still prefer to call it Dorval) has been transformed into a beautiful facility rivalling any of its counterparts in North America. I just returned from a trip to Vancouver and Los Angeles and I wish to commend the folks at Aéroports de Montréal (ADM) for their new commercial zones ten or so new restaurants and boutiques, located in the public and international areas, which has significantly expanded the commercial services available to passengers.

For this commercial project, ADM opted for locally known store and restaurant banners such as *Café Vasco da Gama*, *Archibald*, *Tristan*, *Cirque du Soleil*, *Découvrir Montréal* and *Les Délices de l'Érable*. There are also nationally and internationally branded restaurants and stores, including *Vino Volo*, *Jugo Juice*, *Sushi Shop*, *The Source* and *Relay*.

I must say that it compares nicely to Vancouver International Airport and LAX.

**WEST ISLAND CONNECTION:** En route to Los Angeles to attend the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair, I decided to stop over in Vancouver for a night. There is no finer place in Canada to visit, especially when the weather is nice, than British Columbia's largest city. So where specifically should one go to if you are only looking at an overnight stay? Granville Island ([www.granvilleisland.com](http://www.granvilleisland.com)) wins hands down. This is a living, breathing urban oasis filled with fine waterfront restaurants, theatres, galleries, studios, unique shops, cafes and the

most spectacular fresh food market you've ever seen.

At the marvellous Granville Island Hotel ([www.granvilleislandhotel.com](http://www.granvilleislandhotel.com)) where I stayed, I found an immediate West Island connection. Sales and Marketing Manager **John Fialkowski** went to McGill and spent much of his youth in West Island Senneville, with his grandparents. "I have good memories from the West Island," he says. "Senneville is so rural, quite a contrast to nearby Montreal."

Fialkowski, 32, studied in urban geography at McGill, but ended up going into the hotel business. He started at a place called the Stone Willow Inn near Stratford as the restaurant manager and then headed to British Columbia, first as the manager of a small hotel in New Westminster and then to the Granville Island Hotel as front desk manager. Two years ago he moved to another hotel, but returned to Granville in April with his new position.

In his capacity, Fialkowski books groups and meeting rooms, sets rates and markets the property. "It is a one of a kind place," he says. "You are basically in a seaside resort. I take my bike to work. When I get in I look out the window and I see sailboats."
